

No Need for Re-registration by CGHS beneficiaries to collect indented medicines

This office has received representations from CGHS beneficiaries of the difficulties faced by them for undergoing re-registration when they visit the dispensaries to collect the indented medicines. The matter has been reviewed and it has now been decided that there is no need for re-registration when CGHS beneficiaries visit dispensaries to collect the Indented Medicines. NIC has already developed a module for recording issue of medicines on computers for the sake of record.

These orders shall be complied with immediately.

ANNEXURE 5.IVAA

Text of M.H., O.M. No. F. No. 39-3/2003-04/CGHS/MSD/RS, dt. 23.7.2009 as amended by Corrigendum dt. 3.8.2009

Non-admissibility of Preparation such as Primary Food, Tonics, Cosmetics and Vaccines

The undersigned is directed to say that the question of admissibility or otherwise to beneficiaries under CGHS/CS(MA) Rules, 1944 of preparations which are primary food, vitamins, Haematinic minerals, anti-oxidants, cosmetics and vaccines, has been under consideration for some time. On the recommendations of an Expert Committee and Drug Controller General of India, it has been decided that:

- (i) Product manufactured/ marketed as food supplement, cosmetics and ayurvedic preparation prescribed by allopathic doctors will be inadmissible.
- (ii) Supply of vitamins, minerals and anti-oxidants will be restricted to prevalent CGHS formulary only.
- (iii) Vaccines, in general, will be inadmissible, except Hepatitis B, Influenza and Leprovac Vaccines for high risk individual, is recommended by specialist with justification and countersigned by HoD of concerned speciality of Government Hospital.

These instructions take effect from the date of issue of the Office Memorandum.

Distribution of Life Saving Medicines/Anti Cancer Medicines to CGHS Beneficiaries in NCR Towns at Wellness Center level

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to state that the Ministry has been receiving requests from CGHS beneficiaries residing in the NCR towns of NOIDA, Ghaziabad, Gurgaon and Faridabad, for providing the delivery of life saving medicines/anti cancer medicines at the CGHS Wellness Centre level as against the present system in which these are provided at the Medical Store Depot (MSD), Gole Market, New Delhi. In view of the hardships faced by the CGHS beneficiaries in collecting the above medicines, it has been considered sympathetically by the Ministry and it has now been decided to arrange delivery of the life saving drugs and anti cancer drugs to the CGHS beneficiaries in the above cities at the CGHS Wellness Centre level.

The life saving medicines and anti cancer medicines will be delivered at the Wellness Centre by the supplier between 11AM to 1 PM on third day of placing the indent. The beneficiaries can collect their indented medicines from the Wellness Centre accordingly. In case of emergency they can also collect medicines from Medical Store Depot (MSD), Gole Market, New Delhi, itself on the next working day after due confirmation from the Medical Store Depot (MSD).
