| 2.      | From 25 to 100 employees in the office | Rs. 2000/- (Rs. Two Thousand only)   |
| 3.      | More than 100 employees                | Rs. 3000/- (Rs. Three Thousand only) |

The issue regarding the non-payment of the Annual subscription by various Central Government offices and establishments located in the Tricity has been deliberated upon in detail during the last Meeting headed by Hon'ble Chairman, Central Government Employees Welfare Coordination Committee (CGEWCC), Chandigarh on 21.5.2026.

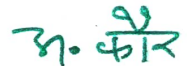
2. The Hon'ble Chairman has strongly expressed that the payment of the annual subscription is not merely a routine financial contribution but a mandatory obligation in terms of the guidelines issued by the Department of Personnel & Training (DoPT), Government of India. It is, therefore, incumbent upon every Central Government office in the Tricity to remit its prescribed annual subscription promptly and regularly.

3. It has further been emphasized that the CGEWCC does not receive any financial grant or budgetary support from the Government for its day-to-day functioning or for carrying out various welfare activities. The annual subscription contributed constitutes the sole source of funds for the Committee. These funds are indispensable for organizing welfare programmes, addressing the grievances and issues of Central Government employees, coordinating inter-departmental welfare initiatives, and implementing activities aimed at the overall welfare and well-being of serving employees, pensioners, and their families.

4. Any delay or default in depositing the prescribed subscription directly affects the functioning of the Committee and hampers the effective implementation of welfare measures envisaged under the DoPT guidelines. It is, therefore, imperative that all Heads of Offices ensure timely remittance of the annual subscription every year. Such timely compliance will not only strengthen the functioning of the CGEWCC but will also enable the Committee to discharge its statutory responsibilities efficiently and achieve its objectives of promoting the welfare, coordination, and collective interests of Central Government employees and their families in the Tricity.

It is trusted that the matter will receive due consideration and that appropriate action will be taken in its true spirit. A formal letter of even number in this regard is enclosed for necessary action.
